## CRIMINAL HISTORY DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

Per Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 246-322-030 Criminal history, disclosure, and background inquiries, employers shall require a disclosure statement for each prospective employee, volunteer, contractor, student, and any other individual associated with the hospital having direct contact with vulnerable adults. (*Vulnerable adult* is defined as any adult of any age who lacks the functional, mental, or physical ability to care for themselves; and includes persons receiving services from any individual who for compensation serves as a personal aide to a person who self-directs his or her own care in his or her home under chapter 336, Laws of 1999.)

Per Regional Code of Washington (RCW) 43.43.834, a business or organization shall not make an inquiry to the Washington state patrol under RCW [43.43.832](#) or an equivalent inquiry to a federal law enforcement agency unless the business or organization has notified the applicant who has been offered a position as an employee or volunteer, that an inquiry may be made. Therefore, the following information shall be used for the purpose of identification in conjunction with the background inquiry: names (legal, maiden, aliases), birthday, sex, height, weight, eye color, hair color, race, and Social Security Number. We may request your fingerprints to obtain, from the Washington State Patrol criminal identification system, a report of your record of criminal convictions for offences against persons, civil adjudication of child abuse, and disciplinary board final decisions. If you are hired before that report is available, your employment will be conditional upon the receipt of a satisfactory report.
